
## PROGRAM UPDATE

**TRI** is collaborating with several key Boulder County criminal justice agencies to plan the implementation of the University of Cincinnati Corrections Institute’s Cognitive Behavioral Intervention Program for people who are incarcerated, on probation and also being served by Mental Health Partners. Together, we will make available proven training modules for helping offenders change the thought patterns that have led them into trouble. Evidence shows that participants can and do change and reduce their likelihood of recidivating. TRI will have three instructors certified to lead this program along with several other volunteers.
