



## TRI Undergraduate Level Internship Description:

Students that are still on track to completing their undergraduate degree have the opportunity to complete an internship with TRI as a **resource specialist**. The resource specialist role will work with a clinical team to offer support in locating, navigating through and brokering resources. Resource support includes finding housing, education opportunities, employment opportunities, pro-social activity opportunities and other resources that may be pertinent to your case. Resource specialists have set office hours in the Longmont Welcome Back Center where they are available for participants that may need guidance on finding certain resources. Students will have the opportunity to contribute to the creation of an online resource bank for resources in Denver County, Boulder County and surrounding areas.

### Requirements:

- ***At least*** a one-year commitment to your role
- 3 letters of reference (personal and/or professional)
- Ability to work both independently and in a team environment
- Knowledge of resources and processes a plus, but not necessary. Resource specialists will be provided with training
